Negation Scope and Negative-Sensitive Forms in Korean

There is a variety of negative-sensitive forms in Korean. In most cases, these forms can receive an analysis as a negative polarity item, though not all of them are interpreted within the scope of negation semantically. In this talk, I will discuss four different types of negative-sensitive item (NSI), their relation to the semantic scope of negation, and their interactions with each other.
